$$\Delta\lambda = \lambda' - \lambda = \left(\frac{h}{m_e c} \right) (1 - \cos \theta)$$

WHERE:

- $\Delta\lambda$ = CHANGE IN WAVELENGTH
- λ' = WAVELENGTH AFTER SCATTERING
- λ = INITIAL WAVELENGTH
- h = PLANCK'S CONSTANT
- m_e = MASS OF THE ELECTRON
- c = SPEED OF LIGHT
- θ = SCATTERING ANGLE

THIS EQUATION ILLUSTRATES HOW THE ANGLE AT WHICH THE PHOTON IS SCATTERED PLAYS A CRUCIAL ROLE IN DETERMINING THE AMOUNT OF ENERGY TRANSFERRED TO THE ELECTRON AND, CONSEQUENTLY, THE CHANGE IN WAVELENGTH.

THE MATHEMATICAL FRAMEWORK

APPLICATIONS OF QUANTUM MECHANICS
