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INTRODUCTION TO MECHANICS

IN THE STUDY OF MECHANICS, WE FOCUS ON THE LAWS OF MOTION ARTICULATED BY SIR ISAAC NEWTON, WHICH ARE PIVOTAL IN UNDERSTANDING HOW AND WHY OBJECTS MOVE. KINEMATICS

KINEMATICS IS THE STUDY OF MOTION WITHOUT CONSIDERING THE FORCES THAT CAUSE IT. IT FOCUSES ON DESCRIBING HOW OBJECTS MOVE IN TERMS OF DISPLACEMENT, VELOCITY, AND ACCELERATION. UNDERSTANDING KINEMATICS IS CRUCIAL FOR ANALYZING THE MOTION OF OBJECTS, WHETHER THEY ARE IN FREE FALL, MOVING IN A STRAIGHT LINE, OR FOLLOWING A CURVED PATH.

KEY CONCEPTS IN KINEMATICS

SEVERAL FUNDAMENTAL QUANTITIES DEFINE KINEMATICS:

- **DISPLACEMENT (s):** THIS REFERS TO THE CHANGE IN POSITION OF AN OBJECT, REPRESENTED AS A VECTOR QUANTITY.
- **VELOCITY (v):** THE RATE OF CHANGE OF DISPLACEMENT WITH RESPECT TO TIME. AVERAGE VELOCITY IS CALCULATED AS TOTAL DISPLACEMENT DIVIDED BY TOTAL TIME.
- **ACCELERATION (a):** THE RATE OF CHANGE OF VELOCITY WITH RESPECT TO TIME. THIS CAN BE POSITIVE (SPEEDING UP) OR NEGATIVE (SLOWING DOWN).

KINEMATIC EQUATIONS

THE FOLLOWING KINEMATIC EQUATIONS HELP RELATE THE VARIOUS QUANTITIES OF MOTION:

- $v = u + at$ (FINAL VELOCITY = INITIAL VELOCITY + ACCELERATION $\times$ TIME)
- $s = ut + \frac{1}{2}at^2$ (DISPLACEMENT = INITIAL VELOCITY $\times$ TIME + $\frac{1}{2} \times$ ACCELERATION $\times$ TIME²)
- $v^2 = u^2 + 2as$ (FINAL VELOCITY SQUARED = INITIAL VELOCITY SQUARED + $2 \times$ ACCELERATION $\times$ DISPLACEMENT)

DYNAMICS

DYNAMICS IS THE BRANCH OF MECHANICS THAT DEALS WITH THE FORCES ACTING ON OBJECTS AND THEIR RESULTING MOTION. UNDERSTANDING DYNAMICS IS ESSENTIAL FOR ANALYZING HOW FORCES INFLUENCE THE BEHAVIOR OF PHYSICAL SYSTEMS. NEWTON'S LAWS OF MOTION FORM THE FOUNDATION OF DYNAMICS AND PROVIDE A FRAMEWORK FOR UNDERSTANDING HOW FORCES CAUSE CHANGES IN MOTION.

NEWTON'S LAWS OF MOTION

THERE ARE THREE FUNDAMENTAL LAWS OF MOTION DESCRIBED BY NEWTON:

- **FIRST LAW:** AN OBJECT AT REST STAYS AT REST, AND AN OBJECT IN MOTION STAYS IN MOTION WITH THE SAME SPEED AND IN THE SAME DIRECTION UNLESS ACTED UPON BY A NET EXTERNAL FORCE. THIS LAW INTRODUCES THE CONCEPT OF INERTIA.
- **SECOND LAW:** THE ACCELERATION OF AN OBJECT IS DIRECTLY PROPORTIONAL TO THE NET FORCE ACTING ON IT AND INVERSELY PROPORTIONAL TO ITS MASS ($F = ma$).
- **THIRD LAW:** FOR EVERY ACTION, THERE IS AN EQUAL AND OPPOSITE REACTION. THIS MEANS THAT FORCES OCCUR IN PAIRS.

APPLICATIONS OF DYNAMICS

DYNAMICS IS APPLIED IN VARIOUS FIELDS, FROM ENGINEERING TO ASTROPHYSICS. FOR INSTANCE, WHEN DESIGNING VEHICLES, ENGINEERS MUST CONSIDER THE FORCES ACTING ON THE VEHICLE TO ENSURE SAFETY AND PERFORMANCE. UNDERSTANDING DYNAMICS ALSO HELPS IN FIELDS LIKE SPORTS SCIENCE, WHERE ANALYZING THE FORCES INVOLVED CAN IMPROVE ATHLETIC

PERFORMANCE.

WORK AND ENERGY

WORK AND ENERGY ARE CLOSELY RELATED CONCEPTS IN MECHANICS. WORK IS DONE WHEN A FORCE CAUSES AN OBJECT TO MOVE, AND ENERGY IS THE CAPACITY TO DO WORK. THE PRINCIPLE OF CONSERVATION OF ENERGY STATES THAT ENERGY CANNOT BE CREATED OR DESTROYED, ONLY TRANSFORMED FROM ONE FORM TO ANOTHER.

WORK DONE BY A FORCE

THE WORK DONE (W) BY A FORCE IS CALCULATED USING THE FORMULA:

$$W = F \times D \times \cos(\theta)$$

WHERE:

- W : WORK DONE
- F : MAGNITUDE OF THE FORCE APPLIED
- D : DISPLACEMENT OF THE OBJECT
- θ : ANGLE BETWEEN THE FORCE AND THE DIRECTION OF DISPLACEMENT

KINETIC AND POTENTIAL ENERGY

THERE ARE TWO PRIMARY FORMS OF MECHANICAL ENERGY:

- **KINETIC ENERGY (KE):** THE ENERGY OF AN OBJECT DUE TO ITS MOTION, CALCULATED AS $KE = (1/2)mv^2$, WHERE m IS MASS AND v IS VELOCITY.
- **POTENTIAL ENERGY (PE):** THE STORED ENERGY OF AN OBJECT DUE TO ITS POSITION OR STATE, COMMONLY GRAVITATIONAL POTENTIAL ENERGY CALCULATED AS $PE = mgh$, WHERE g IS THE ACCELERATION DUE TO GRAVITY AND h IS THE HEIGHT ABOVE A REFERENCE POINT.

MOMENTUM

MOMENTUM IS A MEASURE OF THE MOTION OF AN OBJECT AND IS DEFINED AS THE PRODUCT OF AN OBJECT'S MASS AND VELOCITY. IT IS A VECTOR QUANTITY, WHICH MEANS IT HAS BOTH MAGNITUDE AND DIRECTION. THE CONCEPT OF MOMENTUM IS CRUCIAL FOR UNDERSTANDING COLLISIONS AND INTERACTIONS IN MECHANICS.

CONSERVATION OF MOMENTUM

THE LAW OF CONSERVATION OF MOMENTUM STATES THAT THE TOTAL MOMENTUM OF A CLOSED SYSTEM REMAINS CONSTANT IF NO EXTERNAL FORCES ACT ON IT. THIS PRINCIPLE IS PARTICULARLY IMPORTANT IN ANALYZING COLLISIONS:

- **ELASTIC COLLISIONS:** BOTH MOMENTUM AND KINETIC ENERGY ARE CONSERVED.
- **INELASTIC COLLISIONS:** MOMENTUM IS CONSERVED, BUT KINETIC ENERGY IS NOT.

CALCULATING MOMENTUM

MOMENTUM (P) IS CALCULATED USING THE FORMULA:

$$P = mv$$

WHERE:

- **P:** MOMENTUM
- **m:** MASS OF THE OBJECT
- **v:** VELOCITY OF THE OBJECT

ROTATIONAL MOTION

ROTATIONAL MOTION IS A KEY ASPECT OF MECHANICS THAT INVOLVES OBJECTS ROTATING AROUND AN AXIS. THIS TOPIC ENCOMPASSES ANGULAR DISPLACEMENT, ANGULAR VELOCITY, AND ANGULAR ACCELERATION, WHICH ARE ANALOGOUS TO LINEAR MOTION QUANTITIES.

KEY CONCEPTS IN ROTATIONAL MOTION

HERE ARE SOME ESSENTIAL TERMS RELATED TO ROTATIONAL MOTION:

Q: CAN MOMENTUM BE CONSERVED IN ALL COLLISIONS?

A: MOMENTUM IS CONSERVED IN ALL CLOSED SYSTEMS REGARDLESS OF THE TYPE OF COLLISION. HOWEVER, KINETIC ENERGY IS ONLY CONSERVED IN ELASTIC COLLISIONS, WHILE IT IS NOT CONSERVED IN INELASTIC COLLISIONS WHERE SOME ENERGY IS TRANSFORMED INTO OTHER FORMS.

Q: WHAT IS TORQUE AND WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

A: TORQUE IS A MEASURE OF THE ROTATIONAL FORCE APPLIED TO AN OBJECT THAT CAUSES IT TO ROTATE AROUND AN AXIS. IT IS ESSENTIAL IN UNDERSTANDING HOW FORCES CAUSE ROTATIONS AND IS CRITICAL IN APPLICATIONS LIKE MACHINERY AND VEHICLE DYNAMICS.

Q: HOW DO YOU CALCULATE WORK DONE BY A FORCE?
