MID-20TH CENTURY. KEY FIGURES LIKE CARL ROGERS AND ABRAHAM MASLOW EMPHASIZED PERSONAL GROWTH, SELF-ACTUALIZATION, AND THE INHERENT GOODNESS OF INDIVIDUALS. THIS APPROACH HIGHLIGHTED THE IMPORTANCE OF SUBJECTIVE EXPERIENCE AND THE HUMAN CAPACITY FOR CHANGE.

## COGNITIVE PSYCHOLOGY
