The Cardiff test resulted in a total score of 12-48 points, and the questionnaire resulted in a total score of 0-7 points for stroke symptoms, 0-9 points for symptoms of AMI and 0-6 points on lifestyle factors. Study IV is based on retrospective data from the national quality register, the Swedish registry of cardiopulmonary resuscitation, 2010-2014. Results: A total of 1339 students were included in the CPR training intervention. The DVD-based group was superior to the app-based group in CPR skills, with a total score of 35 (SD 4.0) vs 33 (SD 4.2) points directly after training ($p<0.001$) and 33 (SD 4.0) vs 31 (SD 4.2) points at six months ($p<0.001$).
